# "2017: What does the OECD's automatic exchange of information system mean for trustees and fiduciaries in Switzerland?"

The OECD's Common Reporting Standard is due to be implemented into Swiss domestic law with effect from the start of 2017, so that information gathered from affected Swiss intermediaries will be exchanged for the first time in 2018. The consultation processes are well underway and draft domestic legislation already exists. With the rapid approach of seemingly fully-transparent global private wealth industry, and memories of the implementation processes required by FATCA still very fresh in memories, what will the OECD's Automatic Exchange of Information model mean for Swiss professionals in the sector?
